

WHAT DOES BEST EGG DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?



Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and transaction history
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit history and credit scores

How?

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Best Egg chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do	
How does Best Egg protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Best Egg collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you apply for an account provide account information or give us your contact information provide information to verify your identity use your account provide employment information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Definition	
Affiliate	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 On behalf of Best Egg, Marlette Marketing, LLC's affiliates are Marlette Servicing, LLC, Marlette Technologies, LLC, and Best Egg Services, LLC.
Nonaffiliate	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 On behalf of Best Egg, Marlette Marketing, LLC does not share with non- affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	 Our joint marketing partners include consumer loan lenders.

Other important information

For California Customers: We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with California privacy laws that apply to us.
